Tropical S.A. participated for one more year at the **14th Energy + Hydrogen + Fuel cell International Fair** which was held at Hannover, Germany from the 21st to the 25th of April. Tropical presented on operation two revolutionary hydrogen fuel cell power generators (power 1kW & 5kW), which achieved good feedback because of their noiseless operation and for producing zero emissions.

The air cooled fuel cell power generators with power range from 500Watt to 4kW are specially designed to be used as UPS or as back-up power systems with thousand of applications, while the water cooled fuel cell power generators with power range from 5kW to 20kW and are specially designed for autonomous homes, combined heat & power as well as for grid connected systems.

During the Fair, several meetings as well as discussions took place and some strategic partners were established especially on the peripheral side of the fuel cell systems. Last but not least, the visit from Finland & Salo region representatives for investing into fuel cells as well as from Germany, the state owned organization "Invest in Germany", were led into discussion regarding the investment options for buying Tropical shares or licensing some products and establishing production lines on their countries.
